The minimum requirement for admission	Diploma in Medical Assistant course or BAMS degree from a recognized University
No. of Seats	100 seats per batch
Duration of the Course	3 months (14 hours of online training + 16 hours of onsite training)
Commencement of Course	This course will commence on request from the respective State Governments
Fees	There is no fee for the trainee. This course is currently being offered only on request from the state government. The training costs are being absorbed by the sponsoring Govt.
Brief Description of the Course	This program is a long-term mentoring course for RMAs and AMOs. The syllabus encompasses information pertaining to the Identification, screening and treatment of common psychiatric disorders prevalent in the primary care setup. The candidates will also be taught basic counselling skills and skills for screening cases for referrals.
