The minimum requirement for admission	MBBS degree from any recognized University
No. of Seats	10 seats per batch
Duration of the Course	100 hours online + 25 hours onsite spread over 1 year
Commencement of Course	This course will commence on request from the respective State Governments
Fees	There is no fee for the trainee. This course is currently being offered only on request from the state government and is being run only for MBBS doctors serving in the Govt. sector. The training costs are being absorbed by the sponsoring Govt.
Brief Description of the Course	This program is an intensive training & mentoring course, especially for MBBS medical officers working in prison settings. The syllabus encompasses information pertaining to the screening, Identification, treatment & follow-up of mental disorders which are prevalent in the prison setup. This course also covers legal aspects and rehabilitative aspects pertinent to prison mental health care. There is also a component of continued long-term support for complex cases post-completion of the course.
